AGAPE welcomes both singles and couples, mid 50's and up. We are a caring, sharing group dedicated to Bible study, community participation, church programs, and projects. We support each other in unique life challenges including empty nest, grand parenting, retirement, and aging and health concerns. All are welcome.

CARPE DEUM (seize God) warmly welcomes anyone ages 18-30. We are university (undergrad & graduate) students, newly employed or somewhere in-between. Our desire is to "take hold" of God, stepping up as the church of today. We meet regularly for socials with the option of scheduling additional times for prayer and Bible study.

CHRISTAJAK is a class representing many cultures and various ages. We concentrate on the basics of the Bible and living the Christian life. Occasionally we share in fellowship meals. While most of us are Asian people, we welcome visitors and new members.

ECCLESIA is a class of approximately 30 people, ranging in ages from 30-45 years old. We are made up of singles, married, and married with children, ages toddler to college. Our class enjoys mission outreach projects, Bible studies and social activities — these include retreats, camping, and family inclusive fun. We strive to gather monthly for planned activities. We welcome new members!

FRIENDSHIP CIRCLE is a class characterized by a strong spirit of fellowship consisting primarily of 30-40 seniors with a good representation of single women and men. The Friendship women meet monthly for lunch at Golden Corral, in a private room, except November and December. The men of the class meet once a month, September-May, at Shoney's for lunch and fellowship. The entire group meets three or four times a year for social functions including a fall picnic, Christmas, spring and carry-in dinners. The uniform lesson series of the Mennonite Church is used as our study material.

the GATHERING is a place for 18-23 year olds to worship during the SS hour. We strive to be a supportive and transformational community through teaching, discipleship and fellowship, seeking to glorify God by making Christ visible in our lives.

GRACE FELLOWSHIP is a diverse group of couples, singles, parents of children K-12, and a few empty-nesters, who seek to support and care for one another in all seasons and circumstances. We are earnest in our desire to live faithful Christian lives, only with God's grace and help, often expressed and experienced through His church. We are church to one another and, as part of that, we heartily welcome anyone who wants to join us. Our regular activities include Sunday school (biblical teaching and sharing/prayer), class meals and picnics, retreats, camping, service projects, and small groups.

JUBILEE class consists of approximately 30 persons ranging in age from 35-50 years. We are married with children. Our energetic, but laid-back, group enjoys getting together for monthly and small group activities. We would love to have new members join us.

KOINONIA class members range in age from 40's-60's. We are a diverse group of men and women who are serious about how we relate as Christians to the world as well as deepening our personal relationship with Jesus Christ. We enjoy both social and service activities that are usually planned monthly. New members are always welcome.

LIGHTHOUSE is a class of persons relating to but not limited to those attending Praise Fellowship worship service. We are an intergenerational class. We concentrate on the study of God's word, with a focus on themes related to living our faith and experiencing God. Small groups meet for ministry, prayer and fellowship.

LOGOS is an acronym for "Leaning On God Our Savior." In addition, Logos means "The Word" in Greek. As a blended class of Sanctuary and Praise Fellowship members, LOGOS is committed to study of the Word, prayer, and mutual support in our walk with God. We are comprised of individuals who are mainly in our 50s. Most of our children are young adults, and the majority of us are empty nesters. We enjoy an annual Christmas banquet and weekend retreat, along with various other service and social activities. Members are encouraged to become part of a small group fellowship.

MYF Mennonite Youth Fellowship is a class for all youth who are high school aged. We meet weekly for a time of singing, sharing, and teaching. Teachers and topics vary on a frequent basis. The MYF also meets Wednesday evenings for service projects, social activities, worship or small groups on rotating bases. Annually, the MYF also takes a trip to either the national youth conference or to a service project.

NEW FOUNDATIONS is a class of young adults (ages 25-35). We are establishing our careers and family lives. Our children range from newborn to early elementary ages. The class has topical and Biblical studies geared to meeting real life issues. Sunday evening potlucks and social events are held as well.

OPEN CIRCLE is a class of varying ages (60's plus) and interests. We value personal sharing and caring while trying to be sensitive to individual needs and the inclusion of all members whether married or single in all our events, such as Bible study, teaching, prayer ministry and inspirational book studies. Our annual social events include Valentine's Day and Christmas celebrations and a fall day in the mountains. We are involved in age appropriate service projects and contribute to individual and mission agency ministry needs.

OPEN FRONTIERS class represents a wide variety of cultural backgrounds. Some of us have grown up in Shenandoah Valley and others are quite new to the area. We also welcome new believers and new people to the church as we explore new spiritual frontiers. We range in age from the 20's to the 40's. Our common theme is to support each other as we grown in our walk with Christ. We discuss the HMC sermon topics. Please consider joining us!

SALT class consists of couples and singles with a wide age spread ranging mostly between the 50's and 60's. We are grandparents, parents with an empty nest, and parents with children still at home. We enjoy a variety of Sunday school input, book/Bible studies, uniform lesson series and topical studies. Small groups have been an invaluable asset to our class, providing additional time for sharing, praying together and developing friendships. SINAPI class is a diverse group ranging in age from mid 40's to early 60's. We represent a wide variety of professions, interests and hobbies. We concentrate on three areas: our personal relationship with God, our commitment to each other, and our service to the church and the community. STEPPING STONES is a group (ages 25-45) who are settled into our careers and family lives. Our children range from newborn to middle school ages. We strive to have regular social gatherings, mostly aimed toward kid-friendly activities. We incorporate a blend of Bible study and topical studies and enjoy spirited discussions.
